

CITY OF STONEWOOD WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

Harrison County, WV

Contract No. 1 - WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS: Unit price contract to construct approximately 11,000 feet of 8" and 6" waterline, 25 feet of highway borings, 60 valves, 5 fire hydrant assembly relocations, reconnecting 4 services, relocating one service, 25 tie-ins to existing mains, 1 booster station including piping, pumps, electrical work and site work, 2 PRV vaults, decommissioning of 1 PRV vault, and other work required to provide a complete operating water system.

Contract No. 2 - WATER STORAGE TANK REPAINTING: Lump sum contract to repaint the exterior of one (1) water storage tank measuring 38 feet in diameter by 24 feet in height to the overflow with a nominal volume of 200,000 gallons, including appurtenances and miscellaneous work, disinfection and providing a watertight tank ready to fill, and to install a fence around the tank and to construct a 380 foot aggregate access road. Base bid to repaint tank. Alternate bid to overcoat tank.

Contract No. 3 - WATER SYSTEM OPERATING AND MONITORING EQUIPMENT: Unit price contract to supply radio telemetry equipment and programming to the Owner.
