ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Water System Extension and Improvements project will be received by the Grandview Doolin Public Service District at their office located at 120 Plum Street, Proctor, WV 26055, until 10:00 AM local time on August 1, 2024, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

Separate Bids will be received for Contract No. 1 - Water Treatment Plant Upgrades, Contract No. 2 - Waterline Extension, and Contract No. 3 - Water Storage Tank. The method of bidding will be as follows:

CONTRACT #1 – Water Treatment Plant Upgrades:

Lump sum contract to construct the Water Treatment Plant Upgrades to an existing 350 gpm water treatment plant and one (1) gravel packed vertical water well. The work shall include a 250 SF concrete block addition, a 175 gpm iron & manganese removal filter, all plant building, structures, appurtenances, site and mechanical piping and electrical work, connecting to existing piping and control systems, access and other incidental work required for a complete operating water treatment plant.

CONTRACT #2 – Waterline Extension:

Unit price contract to construct approximately 22,000 feet of 8", 6" and 2" waterline, 160 feet of highway borings, 70 feet of railroad borings, 3,515 feet of horizontal directional drilling, 18 gate valves, 4 fire hydrant assembly, 4 flushout assemblies, making 6 tie-ins to existing mains and other work required to provide a complete operating water system.

CONTRACT #3 – Water Storage Tank:

Lump sum contract to construct the Water Storage Tank measuring 39 feet in diameter by 56 feet in height to the overflow with a nominal volume of 503,000 gallons. Contract shall include telemetry service drop pole, sitework, fencing, sediment control, access roads with drainage provisions and other incidental work required for a complete operating water storage tank.

An OPTIONAL pre-bid conference will be held at the District office at 120 Plum Street, Proctor, WV, 2055, at 10 am on July 16, 2024.

If Contractor intends to let any subcontractors for a portion of the work, Contractor shall take affirmative steps to assure that small, minority and women's businesses are used when possible as sources of supplies, equipment, construction, and services. The bidder, offer or, applicant, or subcontractor agrees that a breach of this certification is a violation of the Equal Opportunity clause in this contact. As used in this certificate, the term

"segregated facilities" means any waiting rooms, work areas, rest rooms and wash rooms, restaurants and other eating areas, time clocks, locker rooms and other storage or dressing areas, parking lots, drinking fountains, recreation and entertainment areas, transportation, and housing facilities provided for employees which are segregated by explicit directive or are in fact segregated on the basis of race, creed, color, or national origin, because of habit, local custom, or otherwise. He further agrees that (except where he has obtained identical certifications from proposed subcontractors for specific time periods) he will obtain identical certifications from proposed subcontractors prior to the award of subcontract exceeding \$10,000 which are not exempt from the provisions of the Equal Opportunity clause; that he will retain such certifications in his files, and that he will forward the following notice to such proposed subcontractors (except where the proposed subcontractors have submitted identical certifications for specific time periods).

A five percent (%5) Bid Bond or certified cashier's check must accompany all bids. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

"DBE REQUIREMENTS"

Each Bidder must fully comply with the requirements, terms, and conditions as set forth in the contract documents to achieve Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation during the performance of this contract. The bidder commits itself to the program for DBE participation and all other requirements, terms, and conditions of the bid conditions by submitting a properly signed bid.

The bidder agrees to make "good faith efforts" to subcontract a portion of the total value of the contract to Disadvantaged businesses. This shall be done in compliance with the six (6) good faith efforts as outlined in 40 CFR 31.36(e). Failure to demonstrate good faith efforts may lead to the rejection of bids. For the purpose of this program, the term "subcontractor" includes all construction, modification, and service work contracted by the bidder in the execution of the work under this contract.

"NONDISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT"

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.
